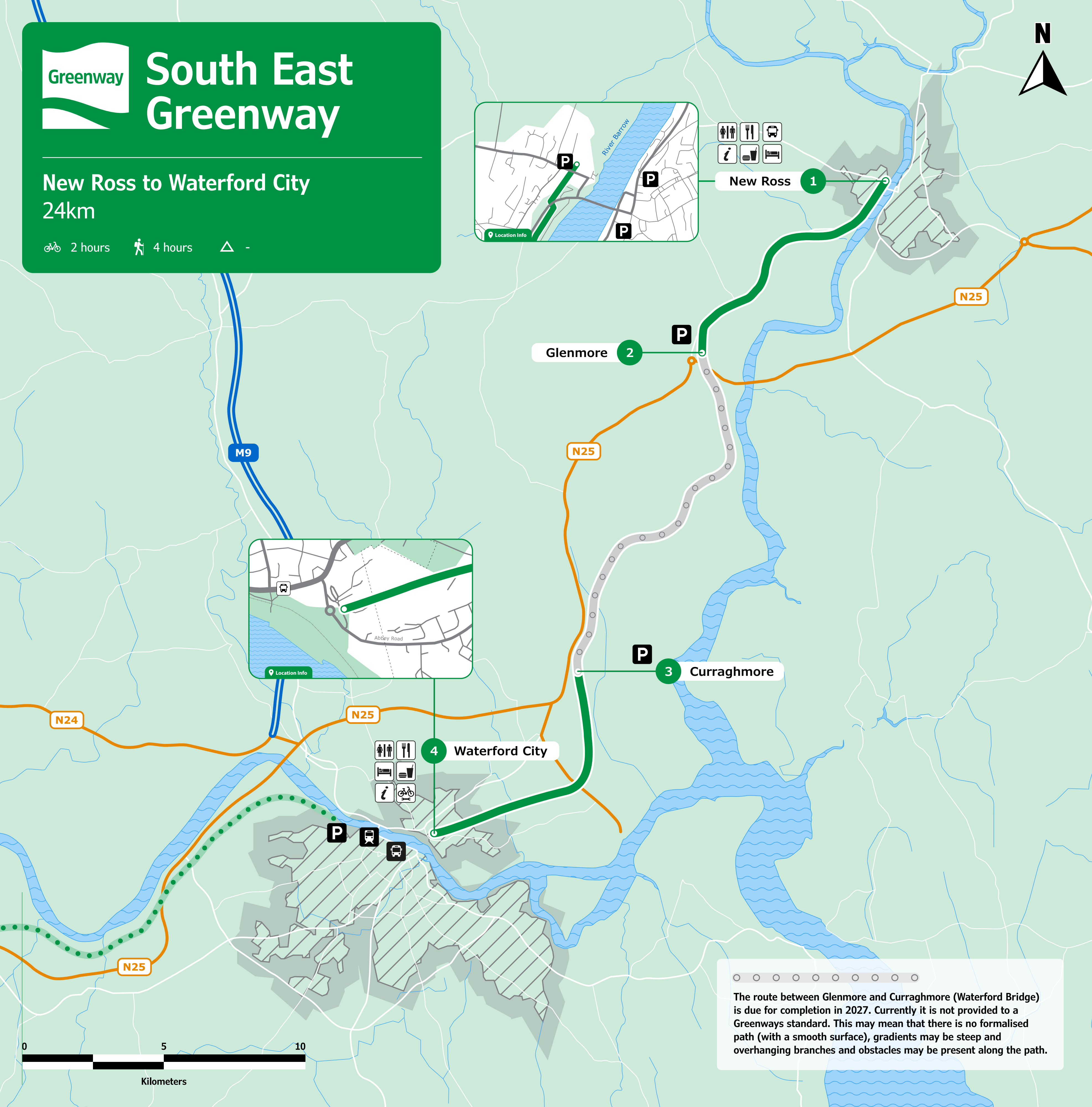

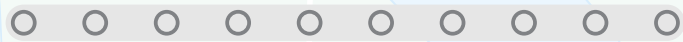

The route between Glenmore and Curraghmore (Waterford Bridge) is due for completion in 2027. Currently it is not provided to a Greenways standard. This may mean that there is no formalised path (with a smooth surface), gradients may be steep and overhanging branches and obstacles may be present along the path.
