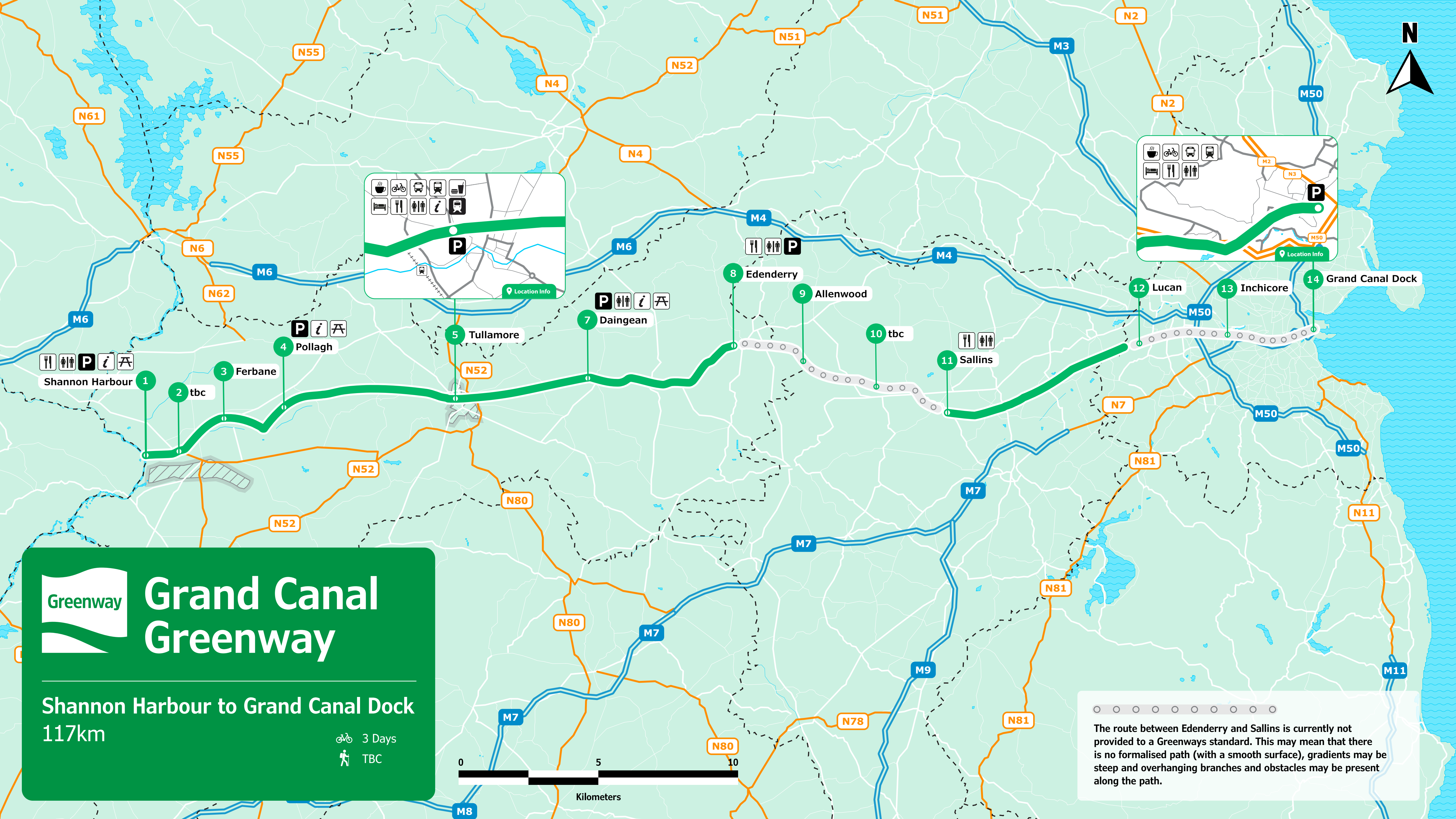




1-5 Shannon Harbour to Tullamore 36km

Begin at the **Shannon Harbour**, where the Grand Canal flows into the River Shannon. The area's 19th-century warehouses and lock house museum echo the canal's industrial heritage. Heading east, the Greenway cuts through **Offaly's peatlands and farmlands**. The route is well-signposted, mostly flat, and ideal for walkers or cyclists. Look for native wildlife as you near **Tullamore**, home to the famous **Tullamore DEW distillery**.

5-8 Tullamore to Edenderry 36km

Departing **Tullamore**, follow the canal past stone bridges, hand-cut locks, and old canal store ruins. The route is peaceful and lightly trafficked, the terrain varies slightly but remains very manageable. As you approach **Edenderry**, the landscape opens further, showcasing rolling fields and farms.

7-11 Edenderry to Sallins 25km

From **Edenderry**, follow the Greenway past open farmland and small villages, eventually reaching **Robertstown**, a model canal town with a charming heritage centre. The path continues smoothly toward **Sallins**, where the scenery shifts toward the gently winding Liffey basin. In **Sallins**, relax at a waterside pub or café before continuing.

11-12 Sallins to Lucan 25km

Leaving **Sallins**, you'll pass the triple locks at **Hazelhatch** and continue toward **Lucan** on well-maintained towpaths. The countryside becomes more suburban with occasional aqueducts, milestone markers, and restored cottages that hint at the canal's engineering past. This section is ideal for leisurely cycling or family walks.

12-13 Lucan to Inchicore 25km

From Lucan, the canal begins threading into Dublin's fringe. Travel along leafy walkways, over quiet bridges, and through the historic neighbourhood of **Inchicore**, home to **Goldenbridge Cemetery** and **Richmond Barracks**. The route remains smooth and accessible, blending pockets of nature with early signs of city life.

13-14 Inchicore to Grand Canal Dock 7km

The final leg leads you from **Inchicore** into **Dublin's vibrant urban core**. The canal is lined with restored locks, landscaped quays. Finish at **Grand Canal Dock**, a modern plaza, set against the backdrop of the canal's terminus, is a lively hub of culture, business, and recreation.
